CERT-trained volunteers inform, prepare for, and assist response during disasters. Bodega Bay has a growing number of CERT volunteers from a variety of professions and experiences. CERT stocks ten strategically located “sheds” with disaster supplies. CERT also encourages and trains shed neighbors to help neighbors in times of need.

The need for CERT and neighborhood volunteers to participate in local disaster preparations and assistance is crucial since we are geographically remote, and first responders and other resources will be stretched thin. CERT is prepared to act in a disaster until first responders arrive.

CERT training includes communications (e.g., ham radio), search, rescue, first aid, and more through our relationship with Northern Sonoma County CERT. Meetings on timely topics such as wildfires, earthquakes, animal rescue, and trauma are held regularly and are open to the public.
